Dear Friends and Colleagues of IASSID,

The massive tsunami, generated by the devastating earthquake on March 11, 2011, sucked down more than twenty thousand Tohoku people all at once. Even now, there are a huge number of sufferers from the quake and tsunami who have no home to return to. Those residents who were forced to be evacuated in the aftermath of the nuclear crisis at Fukushima Daiichi nuclear plant are unable to return to their home.

Tohoku people have received a lot of humanitarian assistance and heartwarming words of encouragement from the international community. We really appreciate such kindness and supports. The Japanese Association for the Study of Developmental Disabilities, JASDD, will continue to support the Tohoku people with disabilities on a voluntary basis.

Such being the circumstances, JASDD is going to busy itself in preparations for the IASSID 3rd Asia-Pacific Regional Conference, Tokyo, to be held from Thursday 22nd through Saturday 24thAugust, 2013. This conference will be organized in coordination with the 48th Annual Meeting of the JASDD from Saturday, 24th through Sunday, 25thof August, 2013. Waseda International Conference Center has been chosen as the place for the meeting. It is located in Tokyo's Shinjuku Ward.

Participants in the coming international conference are expected to come from various fields – psychology, medicine, special education, vocational rehabilitation and the like. The methods of care or support for individuals with developmental disabilities can vary greatly depending on the participants' specialty. Their interests may cover all the generations from infancy to late adulthood. Therefore, we believe that "Multiformity and diversity: Combining individual care and community-based supports" is the most appropriate as the main theme of the conference. With this main theme, expert ideas and opinions will be evolved in keynote lectures, symposia, and oral and poster presentations.

The Science Council of Japan, one of the organizations under the Cabinet Office, has accepted the joint sponsorship for the Tokyo Conference together with JASDD. Waseda University, Division of Culture Program and Faculty of Education and Integrated Arts and Sciences, and Tokyo International Center, Japan International Cooperation Agency are also joining our organizing committee. All members of JASDD are willing to prepare for the Tokyo Conference in close cooperation with these organizations.

We hope that a great number of young professionals from developing countries will participate in the conference. We are thinking of discounting the registration fee for those participants from developing countries in Asia as accommodation charges and bus and cab fares are rather expensive in Tokyo.

We hope that all the IASSID members will participate in the Tokyo Conference and contribute to the program by submitting abstracts for oral or poster presentations.

I am looking forward to seeing you at the IASSID 3rd Asia-Pacific Regional Conference.

Call for abstracts

The presenting author must register for the Tokyo Conference during the period of early bird registration.

Platform Presentation:

Local Organizing Committee (LOC) will prepare 90 minutes session for platform presentation. Coordinators should apply the title and abstract of their own symposium or session to the scientific program committee. LOC expects them to organize their session, i.e., enough number of speakers, 2 or 3, and discussion time within 90 minutes, in total. All the speakers including the coordinators must send their own abstracts to the scientific program committee.

Poster Presentation:

The participants who want to present single issue or one paper are able to apply to poster sessions.
