Editorial rules

- 1. The Journal is the English-language official journal of the Association for the Study of Developmental Disabilities, and in principle publishes one volume per year as an online journal.
- 2. Both members and non-members of the Society may submit papers to the journal. However, the Corresponding Author must be a member of the Society and must be the person responsible for the correspondence during the submission process.
- 3. Articles to be published must be unpublished in other journals and not infringe other copyrights.
- 4. Double submissions must not be made. In addition, papers that should originally be submitted as a single paper must not be split into multiple papers.
- 5. The acceptance or rejection of papers and other articles for publication and the order in which they are published are decided by the Editorial Board.
- 6. The copyright of the articles and other papers published in this journal belongs to the Japanese Society for Developmental Disorders. However, the responsibility for the content of the papers rests with the authors of the papers concerned.
- 7. Ethically problematic research and representations are not permitted. Historical expressions may be included as they are for academic reasons.
- 8.In addition to papers submitted in English, the Editorial Board may request a Japanese translation of the English abstract (a 400-800 character description in Japanese of the methods, results, conclusions, etc.).
- 9. All types of papers will be reviewed by two referees, and Japanese may be used to communicate the results of the review and revision comments.

Rules for submission

1. Screening areas

The journal has review areas on developmental disabilities and related areas of health, welfare, work, education and psychology.

2. Responsibility of the contributor

The contributor alone is responsible for the content of the published article. In experiments involving

humans and animals, care must be taken to ensure that human rights are protected and that there is no abuse of animals. Articles and other materials submitted for publication shall clearly state the statements made in accordance with these ethical considerations.

3. Type and content of submitted papers

3.1. Type

The papers accepted for submission are original papers (theoretical or practical research papers), case studies (original papers dealing with case studies)

Material (articles, research reports and practice reports with material value), Short reports (short original papers dealing with preliminary research), Reviews and perspectives (research papers summarising internal and external research on a specific subject).

3.2. Length of the paper

Original articles, case studies and materials should not exceed 8 printed pages (up to 8 figures and tables).

Reviews and perspectives should not exceed 6 printed pages (up to 6 figures/tables).

Short reports should be no more than 3 pages in print (no more than 3 figures/tables).

The specified length of the paper is the number of printed pages, including cover page (title, authors, abstract, keywords), text, references and figures (one printed page without figures and tables can contain approximately 730 English words).

4. Language of use

The language of the Journal shall be English.

- 5.1. How to submit a paper
- 5.1 Submission of submitted papers
- 5.1.1. non-native English speakers should have their papers checked by a native speaker before submission.
- 5.1.2. Submission instructions are provided separately.
- 6.1. Review of papers
- 6.1 All papers shall be reviewed by the Editorial Board. The review is also carried out by peer review.
- 6.2 Receipt and acceptance of papers

The date of receipt of the submission shall be the date of receipt of the paper, and the date of acceptance shall be the date of adoption after the decision to publish by the Editorial Board. Accepted papers shall be reviewed and proofread by the Editorial Board.

7. Publication fee.

The publication fee shall be JPY 30,000. An additional fee calculated from the printing costs may be levied from the contributor for papers that exceed the word limit indicated in the submission rules.

8. Copyright

All copyright (including the rights under Articles 27 and 28 of the Copyright Act) in the articles published in the Journal

The responsibility for the content of the article shall, however, rest with the author(s) of the article. However, the responsibility for the content of the articles shall be borne by the author(s) of the article concerned.
